RULES & GUIDELINES

- The use of this facility is at your own risk. If you need help or assistance, please ask the Sterling Heights Community Center staff.
- Participating in any physical activity has possible inherent and unforeseen risks which may include injury or death.

 Anyone using the facility must be aware of this fact, assume the risks and be responsible for taking proper precautions.
- Alcoholic beverages are strictly prohibited.
- The Sterling Heights Community Center is a smoke free facility. This includes smokeless tobacco products, hookahs, and vaping. No illegal drugs allowed.
- NO Animals, except service animals permitted through the Americans with Disabilities Act.
- The City of Sterling Heights is not responsible for any lost or stolen articles. It is strongly recommended that you do not bring valuables into the Community Center and that belongings be placed in a locker and secured with a personal lock. Locks are available for purchase at the welcome desk. All locks must be removed daily.
- Children 4 years of age or older may not use the locker room of the opposite sex. Please use the family restrooms within the facility for any changing needs.
- Food and drinks are permitted in designated areas only.
- Non-Marking, soft soled shoes must be worn on the activity floors.
- Participants are asked to change into a separate, clean pair of shoes when using the activity floors (gym, track, fitness and dance studios). Muddy or dirty shoes are not permitted. Shoes are required to be worn at all times while in the facility, unless designated by the activity or program instructor.
- Each area has individual guidelines for your safety and enjoyment. Please follow these guidelines which are posted.
- The City of Sterling Heights reserves the right to add, amend, or delete rules as necessary.
- The Sterling Heights Community Center drop-in fee is \$0 per person for Sterling Heights residents with proper photo identification; \$3 per person (ages 2+) for non-Sterling Heights residents and those not able to provide proper identification. There will be no refunds of drop-in fees paid to the Parks and Recreation Department.
- Proper behavior is required at all times when using the facility. No fighting, stealing, bullying, vandalism, loitering (inside or outside facility), horseplay, littering, or disorderly conduct.
- The City of Sterling Heights reserves the right to eject or terminate privileges of anyone not following the rules of the facility.
- Children 13-15 must show photo ID if not accompanied by an adult. Children 12 years old and younger must be accompanied by a parent or guardian (18+) in all areas of the facility unless they are participating in an organized program or activity.
